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As it concerns the contribution to CEN EAST Project of UNIBO-DISA and SVIMAP and the advancement of WP4 (Monitoring and Reporting Results) according to Project Work Program :

1. UNIBO-DISA

An analysis of Curricula in Built Environment is in progress as it concerns perspectives connected to the actual reformation of the University with the establishment of Schools in place of Faculties and a general restructuring of courses. In particular are programmed meetings with the field of Architecture and Engineering.

Till now we can't report about initiative in Distance Learning (Simulimpresa) in which, although a formal interest of partners no experimentation was started. To this purpose, as the Laboratory of Practice Management by Simulimpresa of UNIBO is still available (Next session will re start at the beginning of October 2013, partners are strongly invited to keep in touch with the Staff Responsible of Simulimpresa (Proff. Daniele Gualdi and Laura Tampieri) to concretely undertake initiatives in this field with a team of students under the tutorship of a teacher . This experience would also allow to European Partners to keep in touch directly with students whose contribute to the project has a strategic relevance.

2. SVIMAP

The role of SVIMAP in WP4 is in the support of individuation and structuring of curricula and ECTS; training courses for Academic and Administrative staff; Support University structures in evaluation processes of educational programmes. Next step of this activity, after the preparation work done in previous meetings, will be a questionnaire sent to partners to gather more cognitive materials about this subject. Also SVIMAP could be involved in Distance Learning and renew its availability, on Project Partners Demand , to support initiatives also with non academic subjects (Associations of Employers and namely in building industry , Professional Orders ect.) particularly as it concerns the dissemination of activities.
